Located on two nearby elementary and middle school campuses, students benefit from small class sizes, daily use of technology, and the implementation of a mastery learning model. The school offers Career Technical Exploration (CTE) and extensive extracurricular activities, including Art, Music, PE, World Languages, and STEM. This year, eighth graders experienced a spring trip to New York City, and elementary students participated in a new program to support social-emotional learning. 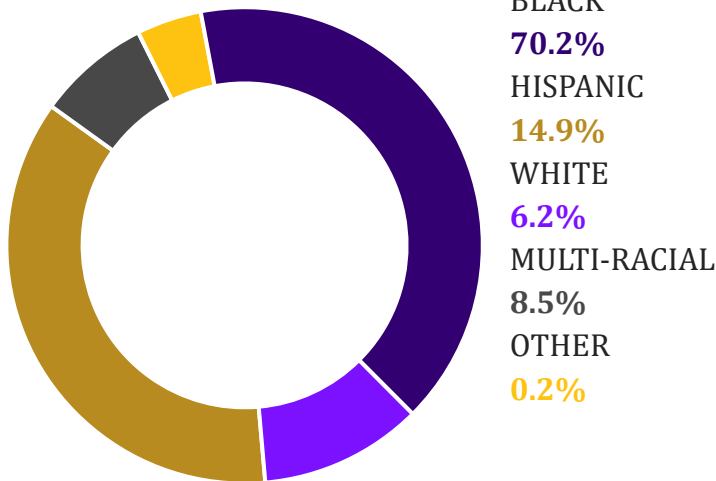

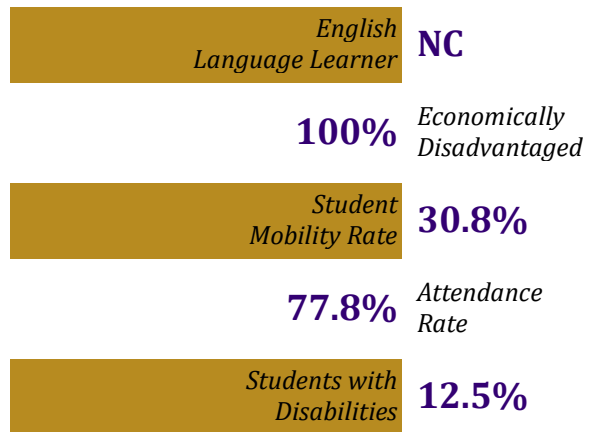


Student Demographics

Progress towards Goals

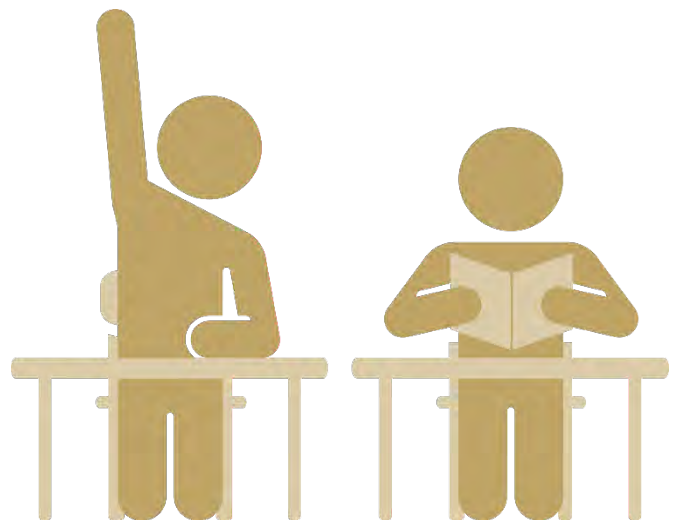
On the state assessment in ELA, test scores have increased steadily over the past five years from 17.6% in 2021 to 33.5% in 2025. In addition, the percentage of students reaching proficiency on the third-grade state assessment has increased from 10.5% in 2021 to 64.7% in 2025, as has the K-3 literacy component, which was rated at 1 star in 2024 and 3 stars in 2025. Attendance at Toledo Preparatory Academy has increased from 61.6% in 2021 to 79.9% in 2024, with a slight dip in 2025 to 77.8%.

Our Academic Goals

- By FY2026, the overall percentage of students reaching proficiency or above on state English Language Arts and Mathematics tests will increase by 30%.
- By FY2026, the overall attendance percentage will increase by 40%.

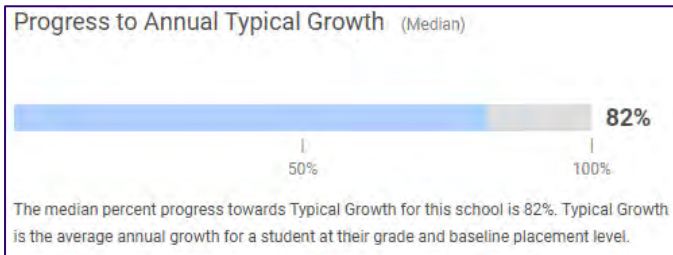

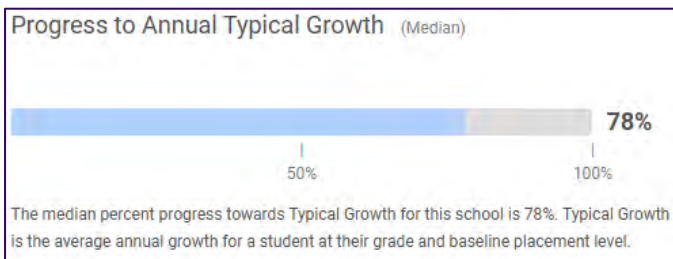

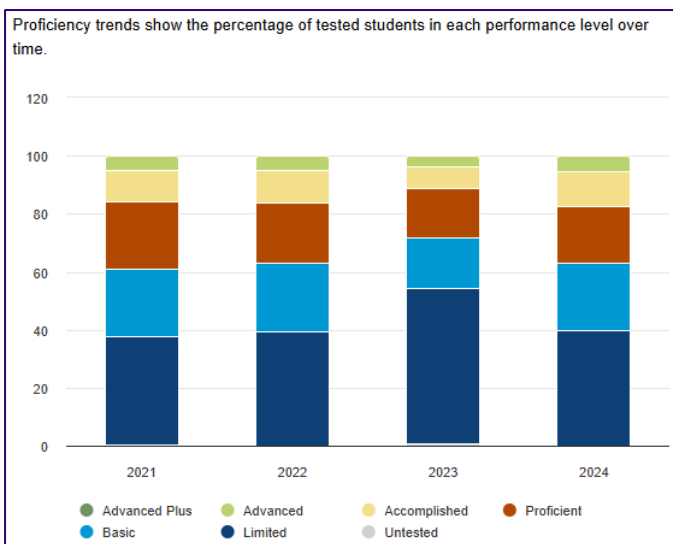
iReady Data Reading
